7	Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is enacted to read:	1
8	"NEIGHBORHOOD ELECTRIC CARS	•
9	A. As used in this section, "neighborhood electric car" means a four-	
10	wheeled electric motor vehicle that:	
11	(1) has a maximum speed of more than twenty miles per	
12	hour but less than twenty-five miles per hour;	
13	(2) complies with the federal requirements specified in 49	
14	CFR 571.500; and	
15	(3) is equipped with head lamps, stop lamps, front and rear	
16	turn signal lamps, tail lamps, reflex reflectors, a parking brake, at least one interior	
17	and one exterior rear view mirror, a windshield, windshield wipers, a speedometer,	
18	an odometer, braking for each wheel, seat belts and a vehicle identification number.	
19	B. Except as provided in Subsection C or D of this section, a	
20	neighborhood electric car, properly registered pursuant to the provisions of the	
21	Motor Vehicle Code, in compliance with the Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act	
22	and driven by an individual with a valid driver's license, may be operated on any	
23	street, roadway or highway under the jurisdiction of either the state or a local	
24	authority if the posted maximum speed limit is thirty-five miles per hour or less;	
25	provided, a neighborhood electric car may cross at an intersection or permitted	
	crossing point at any street, roadway or highway that has a posted maximum speed	
	limit higher than thirty-five miles per hour.	

1	C. A local authority may prohibit the operation of neighborhood
2	electric cars on any road under its jurisdiction if the governing body of the local
3	authority determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety.
4	D. The department of transportation may prohibit the operation of
5	neighborhood electric cars on any road under its jurisdiction if it determines that the
6	prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety.
7	E. Neighborhood electric cars are exempt from the following
8	provisions:
9	(1) the emblems or flashing lights requirement for slow-
10	moving vehicles in Section 66-3-887 NMSA 1978;
11	(2) any requirement for vehicle emission inspections adopted
12	by a local authority pursuant to Subsection C of Section 74-2-4 NMSA 1978; and
13	(3) the minimum motor displacement requirement of
14	Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of Section
15	66-7-405 NMSA 1978."
