9	Section 1) is amended to read:
10	"24-1-1. SHORT TITLEChapter 24, Article 1 NMSA 1978 may be cited as
11	the "Public Health Act"."
12	Section 2. A new section of the Public Health Act is enacted to read:
13	"REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
14	A. A hospital, a long-term care facility or a primary care clinic, shall
15	provide information sufficient for the secretary to make a reasonable assessment
16	based on clear and convincing evidence of its financial viability, sustainability and
17	potential impact on health care access. Information provided to the secretary
18	pursuant to this section shall remain confidential, is exempt from the Inspection of
19	Public Records Act, unless disclosure or use is mandated by the state or federal
20	law, and shall not be used as a basis for suspension, revocation or issuance of a
21	license. The hospital, long-term care facility or primary care clinic shall provide this
22	information to the secretary at least sixty days before the anticipated effective date
23	of a proposed licensure, closure, disposition or acquisition of the hospital, the long-
24	term care facility or the primary care clinic or its essential services.
25	B. The secretary shall issue a notice of finding to the facility within
	sixty days of receiving information from the facility

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1	(1) "hospital" means a facility providing emergency or urgent
2	care, inpatient medical care and nursing care for acute illness, injury, surgery or
3	obstetrics. "Hospital" includes a facility licensed by the department as a critical
4	access hospital, general hospital, long-term acute care hospital, psychiatric
5	hospital, rehabilitation hospital, limited services hospital and special hospital;
6	(2) "long-term care facility" means a nursing home licensed
7	by the department to provide intermediate or skilled nursing care; and
8	(3) "primary care clinic" means a
9	community-based clinic that provides the first level of basic or general health care
10	for an individual's health needs, including diagnostic and treatment services and, if
11	integrated into the clinic's service array, mental health services."
12	Section 3. TEMPORARY PROVISIONOVERSIGHT OF OTHER HEALTH
13	FACILITIESThe secretary of health shall evaluate the need to apply the
14	provisions of this act to all other health facilities as defined in Section 24-1-2 NMSA
15	1978. The secretary shall report findings and recommendations to the legislative
16	health and human services committee by
17	October 1, 2004.
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
