SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 286 appropriates \$5 million from the general fund to the Board of Regents of New Mexico Highlands University (NMHU) to raise employee salaries to the equivalent level of other post-secondary institutions.

Significant Issues

Salaries of employees have traditionally lagged behind those of employees at other institutions. This bill is an attempt to rectify that inequity.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$5 million contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY05 shall revert to the general fund.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

This request was not included in the CHE's funding recommendations for FY05.
