SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 390 appropriates \$25.0 to PED to purchase library materials for the Belen Consolidated Schools.

Significant Issues

PED indicates that if Senate Bill 390 is enacted, the department would administer the monies for the Belen Consolidated School District, which would be used to purchase library materials, including DVD players, TV's, and other audio-video equipment, for the new middle school.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Bill 390 appropriates \$25.0 from the general fund and is recurring.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

PED would administer the funding for the Belen Consolidated School District.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

According to PED, Senate Bill 390 supports the public schools' core performance measures and benchmarks in reading/language arts as well as in other content areas.

If Senate Bill 390 is not enacted, the district will have to identify other funding sources to equip the new middle school library.
