### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 494 appropriates \$50 thousand from the general fund to SAOA for the purpose of senior companion programs in Guadalupe and Quay counties.

#### Significant Issues

Because SAOA did not respond. Details on the uses and client services are unavailable.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$50 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general fund.
