A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE FILM ADVISORY BOARD TO WORK TO RECRUIT THE ANNUAL "GPHORIA AWARDS SHOW" TO ALBUQUERQUE.

WHEREAS, the legislature and the governor are united in their quest to bring good high-paying jobs to the state of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, national exposure from events like the international balloon fiesta help showcase New Mexico and provide state economic development officials with an opportunity to recruit companies and businesses to New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the selection of Albuquerque as the permanent host city for the cable channel G4's annual video game awards show known as the "Gphoria Awards Show" would bring more .150760.3
