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| 15 | WHEREAS, New Mexico's assessment and accountability |
| 16 | system, which rates the performance of students, public schools |
| 17 | and public school districts, was established to comply with the |
| 18 | provisions of the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, the assessment and accountability system tests |
| 20 | whether students in public schools have achieved adequate |
| 21 | yearly progress; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, a public school that fails to make adequate |
| 23 | yearly progress for two consecutive school years is ranked as a |
| 24 | school that needs improvement; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, a public school that fails to make adequate |
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yearly progress for four consecutive school years becomes 2 subject to corrective action; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the assessment and accountability system stigmatize public schools that are ranked as schools that need improvement or that are subject to corrective action: and

WHEREAS, excellent students often leave those schools as a result of the stigmatization, thus removing positive role models for other students in those schools; and

WHEREAS, the assessment and accountability system's measurement of performance through tests shifts the focus of the public education department away from using creative methods to improve public schools; and

WHEREAS, withdrawal from participation in the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 might prevent those adverse consequences;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF **REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the secretary** of public education be requested to formulate a written plan identifying the steps necessary for state withdrawal from the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of public education be requested to present that plan to the appropriate interim committee of the legislature by December 31, 2004; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of public . 151706. 1
