15	Section l. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5

17	"[A.] Each regular session of the legislature shall begin
18	annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January [ <del>Every</del>
19	regular session of the legislature convening during an odd-
20	numbered year] and shall remain in session not to exceed [sixty
21	days and every regular session of the legislature convening
22	during an even-numbered year shall remain in session not to
23	exceed thirty days] forty-five days. No special session of the
24	legislature shall exceed thirty days.
