Section 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the

A. unencumbered balances in state agency accounts
appropriated by the General Appropriation Act of 2004; and
B. all revenue available to state agencies from
sources other than the general fund and federal funds.

Appropriation Act with respect to symbols used, column headings

and stating of amounts is that used in the General Appropriation Act of 2004.
