RELATING TO ELECTIONS; ESTABLISHING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF
ELECTION RESULTS AND INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 1-6-10.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
Chapter 378, Section 1) is amended to read:

"1-6-10.2. [~~ABSENTEE~~] VOTER RETURNS--REPORTING. --

A. The county clerk shall report to the secretary
of state the total votes in each precinct for each candidate
and ballot question as follows:

~~[A.]~~ (1) vote totals by voters who vote in
person on election day;

~~[B.]~~ (2) vote totals by absentee voters who
vote early in person; and

~~[C.]~~ (3) vote totals by absentee voters who

1 vote by absentee ballots by mail.

2 B. The county clerk shall report to the secretary
3 of state the number of voters who signed the signature roster
4 in each precinct and the number of provisional ballots cast in
5 each precinct and the total number of each type of paper ballot
6 printed, cast, spoiled or destroyed by the county for the
7 election.

8 C. The secretary of state shall post the
9 information reported pursuant to this section on the secretary
10 of state's web site. "
