RELATI NG TO CULTURAL AFFAI RS; CREATI NG THE NEW MEXI CO COI N COMM SSI ON TO ASSI ST THE GOVERNOR I N SELECTI NG THE DESI GNS TO BE SUBM TTED TO THE UNI TED STATES M NT FOR THE NEW MEXI CO STATE QUARTER FOR THE FI FTY STATES' COMMEMDRATI VE COI N PROGRAM MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVI SI ON-NEW MEXI CO COI N COMM SSI ON CREATED - MEMBERSH P- - PONERS AND DUTI ES- - CULTURAL AFFAI RS DEPARTMENT TO STAFF.--
A. The "New Mexi co coi n commi ssi on" is created to assi st the governor in sel ecting the designs to be submitted to the United States mint for the New Mexi co state quarter for the fifty states' commerorative coin program The commission shal consist of seven nenbers appoi nted by the governor. Wen

making the appoi nt ments, the gover nor shall take into account the geographic di stribution of the members. Members serve at the pleasure of the governor. The commissi on shall function until the United States min has sel ected the design for the New Mexi co quarter, but no I ater than July 1, 2008. Menbers are entitled to per diem and mileage as provi ded in the Per Di em and MI eage Act, and shall recei ve no ot her compensation, perquisite or allowance.
B. The cultural affairs department shall provide staff support to the commission.
C. The commi ssi on shall solicit and consider design proposal s for the New Mexi co quarter. Menbers of the commi ssi on and their family members may not submit design proposals.
D. The commission shall sel ect no fewer than three and no more than five designs and submit themto the governor for approval. The gover nor shall submit the approved designs to the United States mint, al ong with material explaining the desi gns and why they are representative of the state.

Section 2. APPROPRI ATI ON. -- Si xty thousand dollars $(\$ 60,000)$ is appropriated fromthe general fund to the cultural affairs department for expenditure in fiscal years 2006 through 2008 to pay costs associ ated with the New Mexi co coin commi ssi on. Any unexpended or unencumber ed bal ance remai ni ng at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general . 153318. 1
