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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:			
15	Section 1. Section 22-11-30 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,			
16	Chapter 16, Section 153, as amended) is amended to read:			
17	"22-11-30. RETIREMENT BENEFITS			
18	A. Retirement benefits for a member retired			
19	pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or before			
20	June 30, 1967 shall be paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of			
21	a sum equal to one and one-half percent of the first four			
22	thousand dollars (\$4,000) of the member's average annual salary			
23	and one percent of the remainder of the member's average annual			
24	salary multiplied by the number of years of the member's total			
25	service credit.			
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B. Retirement benefits for a member retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or after July 1, 1967 but on or before June 30, 1971 shall be paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of a sum equal to one and one-half percent of the first six thousand six hundred dollars (\$6,600) of the member's average annual salary and one percent of the remainder of the member's average annual salary multiplied by the number of years of the member's total service credit.

C. Retirement benefits for a member retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or after July 1, 1971 but on or before June 30, 1974 shall be paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of a sum equal to one and one-half percent of the member's average annual salary multiplied by the number of years of the member's total service credit.

D. Retirement benefits for a member retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or before June 30, 1974 but returning to employment on or after July 1, 1974 for a cumulation of one or more years shall be computed pursuant to Subsection E of this section. Retirement benefits for a member retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or before June 30, 1974 but returning to employment on or after July 1, 1974 for a cumulation of less than one year shall be computed pursuant to Subsection A of this section if his date of last retirement was on or before June 30, 1967 or pursuant to Subsection B of this section if his date of last . 153021.3

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1 retirement was on or after July 1, 1967 but not later than June 2 30, 1971 or pursuant to Subsection C of this section if his date of last retirement was on or after July 1, 1971 but not 3 later than June 30, 1974. 4 Ε. Retirement benefits for a member age sixty or 5 over, retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or 6 7 after July 1, 1974 but not later than June 30, 1987, shall be 8 paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of a sum equal to: 9 (1) one and one-half percent of the member's 10 average annual salary multiplied by the number of years of 11 service credit for: 12 prior employment; and (a) 13 (b) allowed service credit for service 14 performed prior to July 1, 1957, except United States military 15 service credit purchased pursuant to Paragraph (3) of 16 Subsection A of Section 22-11-34 NMSA 1978; plus 17 two percent of the member's average annual (2) 18 salary multiplied by the number of years of service credit for: 19 (a) contributory employment; 20 **(b)** allowed service credit for service 21 performed after July 1, 1957; and 22 (c) United States military service 23 credit for service performed prior to July 1, 1957 and 24 purchased pursuant to Paragraph (3) of Subsection A of Section 25 22-11-34 NMSA 1978. . 153021. 3

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F. Retirement benefits for a member age sixty or over, retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or after July 1, 1987 but not later than June 30, 1991, shall be paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of a sum equal to two and fifteen hundredths percent of the member's average annual salary multiplied by the number of years of the member's total service credit; provided that this subsection shall not apply to any member who was retired in any of the four quarters ending on June 30, 1987 without having accumulated not less than 1.0 years earned service credit after June 30, 1987.

G. Retirement benefits for a member age sixty or over, retired pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or after July 1, 1991, <u>but not later than June 30, 2005</u>, shall be paid monthly and shall be one-twelfth of a sum equal to two and thirty-five hundredths percent of the member's average annual salary multiplied by the number of years of the member's total service credit; provided that this subsection shall not apply to any member who was retired in any of the four consecutive quarters ending on June 30, 1991 without having accumulated at least one year earned service credit beginning on or after July 1, 1991.

<u>H. Retirement benefits for a member age sixty or</u> over, who retires pursuant to the Educational Retirement Act on or after July 1, 2005, shall be paid monthly and shall be onetwelfth of a sum equal to the following percentage of the . 153021.3

20	having accumulated at least one year of earned service				
21	<u>beginning on or after July 1, 2007;</u>				
22	(4) for a member who retires on or after July				
23	<u>1, 2008, but no later than June 30, 2009, two and eighty-five</u>				
24	hundredths percent; provided that this paragraph shall not				
25	apply to any member who was retired in any of the four				
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1 consecutive quarters ending on June 30, 2008 without having accumulated at least one year of earned service beginning on or 2 after July 1, 2008; and 3 4 (5) for a member who retires on or after July 1, 2009, three percent; provided that this paragraph shall not 5 apply to any member who was retired in any of the four 6 7 consecutive quarters ending on June 30, 2009 without having 8 accumulated at least one year of earned service beginning on or 9 after July 1, 2009.

[H.] <u>I.</u> A member's average annual salary, pursuant to this section, shall be computed on the basis of the last five years for which contribution was made or upon the basis of any consecutive five years for which contribution was made by the member, whichever is higher. Unless otherwise required by the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, members shall begin receiving retirement benefits by age seventy and six months, or upon termination of employment, whichever occurs later."

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. --Forty-five million one hundred three thousand five hundred dollars (\$45,103,500) is appropriated from the general fund to the educational retirement fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 and subsequent fiscal years for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Educational Retirement Act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year .153021.3

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
