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national medical standards, for women who are eighteen years of 2 age or older and for women who are at risk of cancer or at risk of other health conditions that can be identified through 3 The coverage shall make available human 4 cytologic screening. papillomavirus screening once every three years for women aged 6 thirty and older.

7 **B**. Coverage for cytologic and human papillomavirus 8 screening may be subject to deductibles and coinsurance 9 consistent with those imposed on other benefits under the same 10 contract.

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C. For the purposes of this section:

(1) "cytologic screening" means a Papanicolaou test and pelvic exam for asymptomatic as well as symptomatic women; [and]

"health care provider" means any person (2) licensed within the scope of his practice to perform cytologic and human papillomavirus screening, including physicians, physician assistants, certified nurse-midwives and certified nurse practitioners; and

"human papillomavirus screening" means a (3) test approved by the federal food and drug administration for detection of the human papillomavirus."

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
