RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;

AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978 TO CLARIFY THE NATURE OF

THE CHILE AND THE PINTO BEAN STATE SYMBOLS AND TO DESIGNATE THE

HOT AIR BALLOON AS THE OFFICIAL STATE AIRCRAFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 12-3-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1927, Chapter 102, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
