11 **RELATING TO CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT; CLARIFYING LICENSE**
12 **REVOCATION REFERRAL AUTHORITY FOR JUDGMENTS AND ORDERS FOR**
13 **SUPPORT; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY ACT.**

15 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:**

16 **Section 1. Section 40-5A-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995,**
17 **Chapter 25, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:**

18 **"40-5A-3. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Parental**
19 **Responsibility Act:**

20 **A. "applicant" means an obligor who is applying for**
21 **issuance of a license;**

22 **B. "board" means:**

23 **(1) the construction industries commission,**
24 **the construction industries division and the electrical bureau,**
25 **mechanical bureau and general construction bureau of the**

1 construction industries division of the regulation and
2 licensing department;

3 (2) the manufactured housing committee and
4 manufactured housing division of the regulation and licensing
5 department;

6 (3) a board, commission or agency that
7 administers a profession or occupation licensed pursuant to
8 Chapter 61 NMSA 1978;

9 (4) any other state agency to which the
10 Uniform Licensing Act is applied by law;

11 (5) a licensing board or other authority that
12 issues a license, certificate, registration or permit to engage
13 in a profession or occupation regulated in New Mexico;

14 (6) the department of game and fish;

15 (7) the motor vehicle division of the taxation
16 and revenue department; or

17 (8) the alcohol and gaming division of the
18 regulation and licensing department;

19 C. "certified list" means a verified list that
20 includes the names, social security numbers and last known
21 addresses of obligors not in compliance;

22 D. "compliance" means that:

23 (1) an obligor is no more than thirty days in
24 arrears in payment of amounts required to be paid pursuant to
25 an outstanding judgment and order for support; and

1 (2) an obligor has, after receiving
2 appropriate notice, complied with subpoenas or warrants
3 relating to paternity or child support proceedings;

4 E. "department" means the human services
5 department;

6 F. "judgment and order for support" means the
7 judgment entered against an obligor by the district court or a
8 tribal court in a case ~~brought~~ enforced by the department
9 pursuant to Title IV-D of the Social Security Act;

10 G. "license" means a liquor license or other
11 license, certificate, registration or permit issued by a board
12 that a person is required to have to engage in a profession or
13 occupation in New Mexico; "license" includes a commercial
14 driver's license, driver's license and recreational licenses,
15 including hunting, fishing or trapping licenses;

16 H. "licensee" means an obligor to whom a license
17 has been issued; and

18 I. "obligor" means the person who has been ordered
19 to pay child or spousal support pursuant to a judgment and
20 order for support. "
