Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 68 – Proclaiming March 7, 2005 as "Santa Fe Community College Day" at the Legislature – notes that:

- each year, Santa Fe Community College serves fourteen thousand five hundred students from throughout northern and central New Mexico;
- Santa Fe Community College offers a wide range of educational programs and services to meet the needs of business, government and a diverse population;
- Santa Fe Community College is a comprehensive college that enhances the quality of lives by providing academic, career and personal-enrichment programs;
- the Santa Fe Community College curricula assists students, including adult students, to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to ensure a successful future through associate degrees, transfer curricula, certificates and letters of qualification linked to their continued education and work force training;

- Santa Fe Community College has nurtured and fostered a student-centered educational environment; and
- Santa Fe Community College and its governing board, administration, faculty and staff believe strongly in the mission of the college, which is "helping students succeed and serving our community";
