10 A JOINT MEMORIAL

11 REQUESTING THAT THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION SUPPORT
12 EFFORTS TO REMOVE BONE MARROW FROM THE DEFINITION OF HUMAN
13 ORGANS ILLEGAL TO OBTAIN FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION.

15 WHEREAS, it is against federal statute to obtain "human
16 organs" for valuable consideration, and bone marrow is included
17 in the definition of "human organs" for the purposes of the
18 statute; and

19 WHEREAS, bone marrow, like blood, is a replaceable organ,
20 and the amount of marrow taken for a transplant is replaced in
21 the human body in about four weeks; and

22 WHEREAS, about seventy percent of those who need a bone
23 marrow transplant are unable to receive one because of a lack
24 of people being tested and the subsequent difficulty of finding
25 a suitable donor for a particular recipient from those that are

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
3 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico congressional

5 marrow from the definition of human organs illegal to obtain
6 for valuable consideration; and
