this section shall require that the issuing agency shall issue or deny a permit no later than thirty days after the application for the permit is made, unless the applicant agrees in writing to a longer period. If the agency has not acted on a permit application within thirty days, the permit shall be granted to the applicant. An appeal of an agency decision on the issuance or denial of a permit shall be as otherwise provided by law for the applicable permit, except that the appeal shall be heard within thirty days and a decision rendered within forty-five days of filing the appeal. An appeal of a final decision may be appealed as provided by law. The rules shall provide for an expedited administrative hearing process to appeal a decision; provided that such hearing shall be held within thirty days of the petitioner's request for hearing.

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
