AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO SENTENCING COMMISSION
TO STUDY GENDER-SPECIFIC PROBATION AND PAROLE MODELS AND MAKE
RECOMMENDATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated
from the general fund to the New Mexico sentencing commission
for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 to:

(1) study gender-specific probation and parole
models;

(2) survey existing participants on probation
and parole on the effectiveness of current probation and parole
programs and on their ability to re-enter society;

(3) share results of the survey with the

2 (4) make recommendations on implementing best
3 practices in New Mexico.

4 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
5 at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general
