AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE FACULTY ENDOWMENT FUND TO CREATE ENDOWMENTS AT FOUR-YEAR AND TWO-YEAR PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS; RECONCILING CONFLICTING AMENDMENTS TO THE SAME SECTION OF LAW BY REPEALING LAWS 2003, CHAPTER 379, SECTION 1; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 21-1-27.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2002, Chapter 31, Section 1, as amended by Laws 2003, Chapter 379, Section 1 and by Laws 2003, Chapter 392, Section 1) is amended to read:

"21-1-27.1. FACULTY ENDOWMENT FUND CREATED.--

A. The "faculty endowment fund" is created in the state treasury. The fund shall consist of appropriations,

2 and bequests. Money in the fund shall not revert at the end of  
3 any fiscal year.

4 B. The faculty endowment fund shall be administered  
5 by the [~~commission on~~] higher education department. [~~Except as~~  
6 ~~provided in Subsection J of this section~~] Money shall be  
7 disbursed only on warrant of the secretary of finance and  
8 administration upon voucher signed by the [~~executive director~~  
9 ~~of the commission on~~] secretary of higher education or [~~his~~  
10 the secretary's] authorized representative.

11 C. Money shall be disbursed from the faculty  
12 endowment fund only to establish endowments [~~for chairs,~~  
13 ~~professorships and faculty development programs at four-year~~  
14 at public post-secondary educational institutions as provided  
15 in this section. [~~Except as provided in Subsection J of this~~  
16 ~~section~~] An institution shall not receive a disbursement for an  
17 endowment until that institution has notified the [~~commission~~  
18 ~~on~~] higher education department that it has received matching  
19 funds for the endowment from other than governmental sources in  
20 [~~an amount that is equal to or greater than the amount~~  
21 ~~authorized by this section to be disbursed for the endowment~~]  
22 the amount required by this section.

2 (1) eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) each  
3 for the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university,  
4 New Mexico institute of mining and technology and the  
5 university of New Mexico school of medicine; provided that no  
6 disbursement shall be made pursuant to this paragraph unless  
7 the institution has shown to the satisfaction of the higher  
8 education department that it has received matching funds in an  
9 amount equal to at least forty percent of the disbursement;

10 (2) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) each for  
11 New Mexico highlands university, eastern New Mexico university,  
12 western New Mexico university and northern New Mexico state  
13 school; provided that no disbursement shall be made pursuant to  
14 this paragraph unless the institution has shown to the  
15 satisfaction of the higher education department that it has  
16 received matching funds in an amount equal to at least thirty  
17 percent of the disbursement; and

18 (3) for the total endowments at New Mexico  
19 military institute, community colleges authorized pursuant to  
20 the Community College Act, branch community colleges authorized  
21 pursuant to Chapter 21, Article 14 NMSA 1978 and technical and  
22 vocational institutes authorized pursuant to the Technical and  
23 Vocational Institute Act, ten million dollars (\$10,000,000);

11 shall not be expended but shall be invested by the institutions  
12 in accordance with the prudent ~~[man]~~ investor rule, and in  
13 accordance with the provisions of Section 21-1-38 NMSA 1978.  
14 The income from the investments shall be used by the  
15 institutions to provide funding for chairs, lectureships,  
16 professorships, ~~[and]~~ scholarships, graduate assistantships,  
17 faculty development programs, and other purposes including  
18 paying all or a portion of the salary of the faculty member or  
19 the expenses necessary to support associated academic  
20 activities.

23 ~~commission on higher education shall be allocated as follows:~~

3 G. No later than July 1 of calendar years 2007,  
4 2008 and 2009, the higher education department shall report  
5 to the legislative finance committee on disbursements made  
6 pursuant to this section. The report shall include the  
7 amounts disbursed to each institution, the amount of matching  
8 funds and their source and the purpose of the endowments."

9 Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Fifty million dollars  
10 (\$50,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
11 faculty endowment fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2006  
12 and subsequent fiscal years for the purpose of making  
13 disbursements for endowments pursuant to Section 21-1-27.1  
14 NMSA 1978. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
15 at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general  
16 fund.

17 Section 3. REPEAL.--Laws 2003, Chapter 379, Section 1  
18 is repealed.
