23	percent of the federal poverty level;

- (3) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for aim high programs increasing the quality of early child care programs;
- (4) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for scholarships to help early childhood teachers learn more about child development and early learning while earning college degrees;
- (5) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for wage supplements for early childhood teachers, based on the educational level that those teachers achieve; and
- (6) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to improve accreditation for child care providers.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
