- 3. On page 15, lines 10 through 15, strike Subsection NN in its entirety.
 - 4. Reletter the succeeding subsection accordingly.
- 5. On page 15, line 16, strike "of the state or of", strike line 17 through "state" and insert in lieu thereof "or any other agency that investigates criminal violations,".
- 6. On page 15, line 18, after "investigation" insert "pursuant to a memorandum of understanding with that agency".
- 7. On page 15, line 19, strike the period and quotation mark and insert in lieu thereof "; and".
- 8. On page 15, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following new subsection:
- "00. records of refunds or credits that the department is required to make available for public inspection pursuant to Section 7-1-29 NMSA 1978."".,

and thence referred to the BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY COMMITTEE.
