## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR NURSING LEADERSHIP AND NURSE RETENTION PROGRAMS IN NEW MEXICO.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 as follows:

(\$125,000) to contract with a statewide organization representing hospitals and health systems to develop an on-line reporting system of demographic information and quality measures and to develop guidelines for nurse staffing ratios; and
