AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT FOR CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMPUTERIZED LEARNING SYSTEM AND AN ASSESSMENT OF ITS PERFORMANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Four million five hundred thousand dollars (\$4,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 as follows:

four million four hundred thousand dollars (1) (\$4,400,000) to continue implementation of a computerized learning system that aligns public school criteria to state academic content standards and the statewide assessment program through local and wide-area networks and that:

22	(2) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
23	conduct a study and assessment of the effectiveness of the
24	computerized learning system implemented in 2003.
25	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining

at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
