16	Section 1. Section 22-8-18 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1974,
17	Chapter 8, Section 8, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"22-8-18. PROGRAM COST CALCULATIONLOCAL SCHOOL BOARD

20	A. The total program units for the purpose of
21	computing the program cost shall be calculated by multiplying
22	the sum of the program units itemized as Paragraphs (1) through
23	(5) in this subsection by the instructional staff training and
24	experience index and adding the program units itemized as
25	Paragraphs (6) through $[(10)]$ (11) in this subsection. The

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1 itemized program units are as follows: 2 (1)early childhood education; 3 (2) basic education; special education, adjusted by subtracting 4 (3) 5 the units derived from membership in class D special education 6 programs in private, nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers; 7 (4) bilingual multicultural education; fine arts education; 8 (5) 9 size adjustment; (6) 10 at-risk program; (7) 11 (8) enrollment growth or new district 12 adjustment; 13 special education units derived from (9) 14 membership in class D special education programs in private, 15 nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers; [and] 16 (10) national board for professional teaching 17 standards certification; and 18 (11) military-connected students. 19 Β. The total program cost calculated as prescribed 20 in Subsection A of this section includes the cost of early 21 childhood, special, bilingual multicultural, fine arts and 22 vocational education and other remedial or enrichment programs. 23 It is the responsibility of the local school board to determine 24 its priorities in terms of the needs of the community served by 25 that board. Funds generated under the Public School Finance .160589.1

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Act are discretionary to local school boards, provided that the special program needs as enumerated in this section are met."

Section 2. A new section of the Public School Finance Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] MILITARY-CONNECTED STUDENTS PROGRAM UNITS.--The number of program units for military-connected students is determined by multiplying the full-time equivalent MEM as reflected in the district's prior-year federal impact aid application by a cost differential determined annually by the department that will equal seventy-five percent of the total amount generated by the total number of military-connected students in the district."

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
