of computer-assisted remote hunting;

- entice, possess or confine an animal or bird for the purpose of computer-assisted remote hunting; or
- import into or export from this state an animal or bird, or any part of an animal or bird, that is taken or captured by computer-assisted remote hunting.
- A person who violates the provisions of this section shall be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of Section 17-2-10 NMSA 1978.
- C. When a person who violates the provisions of this section possesses a license, certificate or permit issued by the state game commission, the license, certificate or permit shall be subject to revocation by the commission pursuant to Sections 17-1-14 and 17-3-34 NMSA 1978.

D. As used in this section:

- "computer-assisted remote hunting" means (1) the use of a computer or other electronic device, equipment or software to access the internet and remotely control the aiming and discharge of a bow, crossbow or firearm of any kind for the purpose of hunting, taking or capturing an animal or bird; and
- "facilities for computer-assisted remote (2) hunting" means the real property and improvements on the property associated with computer-assisted remote hunting, including hunting blinds, offices and rooms equipped to facilitate computer-assisted remote hunting."
