21	Section 1. A new section of the Public Employees
22	Retirement Act is enacted to read:

Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public employees retirement association for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 and subsequent fiscal years to carry out the provisions of Section 1 of this act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2006.

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
