AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION  
PROGRAMS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000)  
is appropriated from the general fund to the department of  
health for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 as follows:

(1) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to  
expand the male involvement program to southern and eastern New  
Mexico and to develop a youth alliance program component that  
could be linked to school-based health center programs; and

(2) two hundred fifty thousand dollars  
(\$250,000) to develop and implement a model community-wide  
program that involves parents, schools, businesses, faith-based

1 organizations, health care providers and civic organizations in  
2 providing support to youth in the areas of employment skills,  
3 healthy behaviors, sex education and academic achievement. The  
4 program shall be modeled after the Carrera pregnancy prevention  
5 program that links school-based programs, parallel family  
6 systems, community service and recreational activities.

7 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
8 at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general  
9 fund.
