AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO HIGHLANDS UNIVERSITY FOR A YOUTH EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVE TO MARKET AND PROMOTE THE STATE AND ITS CULTURE THROUGH A FILM THAT FEATURES THE STATE'S STORIES, TRADITIONS, FOLK ART AND PEOPLE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal years 2006 and 2007 for a youth educational initiative to market and promote the state and its culture through a film that features the state's stories, traditions, folk art and people. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the
