19	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONDEFEASANCE OF OUTSTANDING STATE
20	OFFICE BUILDING TAX REVENUE BONDSThirty-one million dollars
21	(\$31,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
22	state building bonding fund for expenditure in fiscal years
23	2006 and 2007 for the purpose of defeasing all outstanding
24	state office building tax revenue bonds. Any unexpended or
25	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007

Section 2. APPROPRIATION--CAPITAL PROJECTS.--Eighty-eight million six hundred thousand dollars (\$88,600,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the property control division of the general services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2006 through 2011 for the capital projects specified in this section. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2011 shall revert to the general fund. The appropriation shall be expended in the following amounts for the following projects:

A. twenty-three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$23,500,000) to purchase and renovate, equip and furnish the public employees retirement association building on Paseo de Peralta in the city of Santa Fe. The purchase shall be made at a price negotiated with the retirement board of the public employees retirement association that is not less than the fair market value of the property and building;

B. eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a parking structure in the central capitol campus in Santa Fe, in cooperation with the New Mexico legislative council, pursuant to the capitol buildings master plan developed by the capitol buildings planning commission and after review by the commission. Upon completion of the parking structure, the property control division shall transfer the parking structure and associated real estate to the New Mexico .161479.1

4 C. thirty-one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$31,800,000) to acquire land and plan, design, construct and equip a state laboratory facility in Bernalillo 7 county;

8 ten million three hundred thousand dollars D. 9 (\$10,300,000) for capital projects at the southern New Mexico 10 rehabilitation center;

Ε. eleven million dollars (\$11,000,000) for capital projects at the New Mexico behavioral health center at Las Vegas; and

Section 3. Laws 2001, Chapter 166, Section 1, as amended by Laws 2004, Chapter 123, Section 6 and Laws 2005, Chapter 320, Section 1, is amended to read:

"Section 1. AUTHORIZATION TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY --APPROPRIATION. --

In order to acquire the following properties for Α. use as state agency offices in Santa Fe county, the property control division of the general services department may:

(1) purchase and renovate, equip and furnish the national education association building on South Capitol .161479.1

(2) plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a new office building with integrated parking at the west capitol complex on Cerrillos road, pursuant to the design funded by Subsection I of Section 14 of Chapter 118 of Laws 1998, at a price not to exceed twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000); and

8 [(3) purchase and renovate, equip and furnish

(4)] (3) purchase land within or in close proximity to the public safety campus as set out in the capitol buildings master plan developed by the capitol buildings planning commission; provided that no land shall be purchased pursuant to this paragraph that does not have, in place, water, sewer, electricity and other necessary infrastructure.

[B. In addition to the acquisitions authorized in Subsection A of this section, the property control division of the general services department may:

(1) in cooperation with the New Mexico legislative council, pursuant to the capitol buildings master plan developed by the capitol buildings planning commission and after review by the commission plan, design, construct and equip a parking structure in the central capitol campus in Santa Fe. Upon completion of the parking structure, the .161479.1

1 property control division shall transfer the parking structure 2 and associated real estate to the New Mexico legislative 3 council. After the transfer, the legislative council shall 4 operate and maintain the parking structure; and (2) expend up to eighteen million one hundred 5 thousand dollars (\$18,100,000) of the net proceeds from state 6 7 office building tax revenue bonds to acquire land and plan, 8 design, construct and equip a state laboratory facility in 9 Bernalillo county. 10 C.] B. The acquisitions of property pursuant to 11 Subsection A of this section shall be made in the priority 12 order listed in that subsection. Purchases authorized in 13 [Paragraphs (1), (2) and (4) of] Subsection A of this section 14 shall be made at a price not to exceed the value of the 15 property established by the taxation and revenue department 16 using generally accepted appraisal techniques for the type of 17 property purchased. [The purchase authorized in Paragraph (3) 18 of Subsection A of this section shall be made at a price 19 negotiated with the retirement board of the public employees 20 retirement association that is not less than the fair market 21 value of the property and building.]" 22

Section 4. REPEAL.--Laws 2005, Chapter 320, Section 8 is repealed.

Section 5. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately. .161479.1
