15	Section 1. APPROPRIATION

19	behavioral health services in southern New Mexico as follows:
20	(1) two million five hundred thousand dollars
21	(\$2,500,000) for inpatient assessment and treatment of
22	individuals who are under protective custody or are under
23	thirty-day involuntary civil commitment pursuant to Sections
24	43-1-10 through 43-1-13 NMSA 1978;
25	(2) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000)
