18	fiscal year 2007 to implement a mentoring program that pairs
19	senior citizen volunteers recruited through the aging and long-
20	term services department with foster children aged eighteen to
21	twenty-one years old. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
22	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the
23	general fund.
