AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL ADVANCED PLACEMENT  
INITIATIVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. One million three hundred thousand dollars  
(\$1,300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2007  
to fund a program to expand advanced placement participation in  
public schools around the state, in the following amounts for  
the following purposes:

(1) seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000)  
to expand advanced placement for nontraditional participants;

(2) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)  
for an advanced placement summer institute;

1 (3) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to  
2 expand advanced placement opportunities for rural school  
3 students; and

4 (4) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to  
5 expand advanced placement teacher professional development.

6 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
7 at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general  
8 fund.
