17	Section 1. Section 18-14-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
18	Chapter 250, Section 1) is amended to read:

20	<u>NMSA 1978</u> may be cited as the "New Mexico Film Museum Act"."
21	Section 2. Section 18-14-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
22	Chapter 250, Section 3) is amended to read:
23	"18-14-3. MUSEUMLOCATIONPROPERTY
24	A. The "New Mexico film museum" is created within
25	the [tourism department] <u>cultural affairs department</u> . The
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1 museum shall be located in Santa Fe. 2 B. All real or personal property held or 3 subsequently acquired for the operation of the museum shall be 4 under the control and authority of the board. 5 C. Funds or other property received as a gift, endowment or legacy shall remain under the control of the board 6 7 and shall, upon acceptance, be used for the operation of the museum." 8 9 Section 3. Section 18-14-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003, 10 Chapter 250, Section 4) is amended to read: 11 "18-14-4. BOARD--APPOINTMENT--TERMS--OFFICERS.--12 The board of trustees of the museum is created. Α. The board shall consist of eleven members who 13 Β. 14 are residents of New Mexico, appointed by the governor with the 15 advice and consent of the senate. In making the appointments, 16 the governor shall give due consideration to the geographic 17 distribution of the members' places of residence. The members 18 shall be persons who have expertise or have demonstrated a 19 continuing interest in the fields of film, filmmaking or 20 museums; provided that 21 [(1) one of the members shall be the director 22 of the museum division of the office of cultural affairs or his 23 designee; 24 (2) one of the members shall be the director 25 of the New Mexico film division of the economic development .159396.1

2 (3) two members shall be film actors; 3 (4) two members shall be screenwriters; 4 (5) two members shall be film technicians; and 5 (6) one member representing the Indian 6 nations, tribes and pueblos located wholly or partially in New 7 Mexicol. 8 The board members shall be appointed for terms C. 9 of four years or less so that all terms are coterminous with 10 the current term of the governor who appointed them. The board 11 members shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. 12 The secretary of [tourism] cultural affairs or D. 13 the secretary's designee shall be an ex-officio nonvoting 14 member of the board. 15 The president of the board shall be designated Ε. 16 by the governor and shall serve in that capacity at the 17 pleasure of the governor. Other officers shall be elected 18 annually by the board at its first scheduled meeting after July 19 1 of each year." 20 Section 4. TEMPORARY PROVISION--TRANSFERS.--21 A. On the effective date of this act, all 22 functions, appropriations, money, personnel, records, files, 23 furniture, equipment and other property of the New Mexico film 24 museum of the tourism department shall be transferred to the 25 cultural affairs department. .159396.1

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1 Β. On the effective date of this act, all 2 contractual obligations of the New Mexico film museum of the 3 tourism department shall be binding on the cultural affairs 4 department. 5 APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars Section 5.

(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the cultural affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 to provide for operational costs for the New Mexico film museum. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund. Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the 12 provisions of this act is July 1, 2006.

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
