DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER A PROGRAM OF MEDICAL OR PREMIUM

ASSISTANCE FOR PERSONS INELIGIBLE FOR FEDERALLY FUNDED PUBLIC

ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 27-2-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973, Chapter 376, Section 16, as amended) is amended to read:

"27-2-12. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.--

A. Consistent with the federal act and subject to the appropriation and availability of federal and state funds, the medical assistance division of the [human services] department may by [regulation] rule provide medical assistance, including the services of licensed doctors of oriental medicine, licensed chiropractic physicians and licensed dental .160375.1GR

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B. Subject to appropriation and availability of federal, state or other funds, the medical assistance division of the department may by rule provide medical assistance, including assistance in the payment of premiums for medical or long-term care insurance, to persons who are residents of the state of New Mexico and who are ineligible for public assistance under the federal act."

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
