AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS; CREATING AN ADDITIONAL JUDGESHIP IN THE
THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 34-6-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968,
Chapter 69, Section 9, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-6-6. JUDGES--THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT.--There shall be
[~~seven~~] eight district judges in the third judicial district."

Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--DISTRICT JUDGE
APPOINTMENT.--The additional district court judgeship provided
in this 2006 act shall be filled by appointment by the governor
pursuant to the provisions of Article 6 of the constitution of
New Mexico.

Section 3. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred thirteen
thousand five hundred sixty-six dollars (\$313,566) is

1 appropriated from the general fund to the third judicial
2 district court for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 for salaries
3 and benefits and furniture, supplies and equipment for one
4 additional district judge and support staff. Any unexpended or
5 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007
6 shall revert to the general fund.

7 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
8 provisions of this act is July 1, 2006.
