15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 17-2-26 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1912,
17	Chapter 85, Section 45, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"17-2-26. CIVIL LIABILITY
19	A. The director of the department of game and fish,
20	or any other officer charged with enforcement of the laws
21	relating to game and fish if so directed by the director, may
22	bring a civil action in the name of the state against any
23	person unlawfully wounding or killing, or unlawfully in
24	possession of, any game quadruped, bird or fish, or part
25	thereof [ <del>and</del> ]. <u>The state game commission shall establish</u>

1	<u>damages recoverable by civil judgment on a game animal, bird or</u>
2	fish designated to be a trophy animal by commission rule. The
3	damages recovered shall not be limited or reduced by the extent
4	of fines assessed under any criminal statute. The director of
5	the department of game and fish, or any other officer
6	designated by the director, shall recover judgment for the
7	following minimum sums, <u>unless a higher minimum is established</u>
8	by the state game commission, as [damage] damages for the
9	taking, killing or injuring:

3	B. The department of game and fish shall not award
4	or issue a license, permit or certificate to a debtor owing
5	damages pursuant to Subsection A of this section until the
6	judgment has been paid in full to the department.
7	$[B_{\bullet}]$ <u>C.</u> No verdict or judgment recovered by the
8	state in an action shall be for less than the sum fixed in this
9	section. The action for damages may be joined with an action
10	for possession, and recovery may be had for the possession as
11	well as the damages.
12	$[G_{\bullet}]$ D. The pendency or determination of an action
13	for damages or payment of a judgment, or the pendency or
14	determination of a criminal prosecution for the same taking,
15	wounding, killing or possession, is not a bar to the other, nor
16	does either affect the right of seizure under any other
17	provision of the laws relating to game and fish.

 $[\underline{D}_{\cdot}]$  <u>E</u>. The provisions of this section shall not be interpreted to prevent, constrain or penalize a Native American for engaging in activities for religious purposes, as provided in Section 17-2-14 or 17-2-41 NMSA 1978.

[E.] <u>F.</u> The provisions of this section shall not apply to a landowner or lessee, or employee of either [<del>of</del> them], who kills an animal, on private land in which [they have] the person has an ownership or leasehold interest, that .159526.1
