18	appoint a half-time liaison for foster services to focus on
19	social, housing, employment and educational needs of children
20	ages eighteen to twenty-one who have been in state foster care
21	and to ensure that related agency staff are available for
22	transition planning.
23	Section 2. COORDINATION WITH OTHER AGENCIESThe liaison

C. make recommendations to departments, agencies and the legislative welfare reform oversight committee on strategies to properly fund programs and provide guidance for children ages eighteen to twenty-one who have been in foster care.
