11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES
12 DEPARTMENT FOR A STATEWIDE INFORMATION AND REFERRAL TASK FORCE
13 AND PROGRAM.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Four hundred sixty-two
17 thousand dollars (\$462,000) is appropriated from the general
18 fund to the aging and long-term services department for
19 expenditure in fiscal year 2007 to fund project management and
20 operating expenses of the existing 211 information and referral
21 system, expansion into new areas of the state, a statewide
22 information and referral task force, development of a strategic
23 plan and certified operator and data entry training. Any
24 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
25 fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
