14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne million two hundred
16	thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the general
17	fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for
18	expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2010 to fund a
19	comprehensive hydrogeologic study of the Sacramento mountains
20	by the Otero soil and water conservation district, provided
21	that all work funded through this appropriation shall be
22	coordinated with the bureau of geology and mineral resources
23	and the office of the state engineer. Any unexpended or
24	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2010
25	shall revert to the general fund.
