16	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
17	A. Three million five hundred thousand dollars

20	administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 to provide
21	the Albuquerque police department with the necessary computer
22	software and hardware upgrades for the comprehensive
23	information system to:
24	(1) provide for officer-scheduling and case-

8	to allow real-time information sharing with other criminal
9	justice systems; and
10	(4) ensure that the comprehensive information
11	system includes a police records management system, police and
12	fire computer-aided dispatch, police and fire mobile data

14	warehouse available to multiple agencies and jurisdictions.
