### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of HCPAC Amendment

The House Consumer and Public Affairs Committee amended House Bill 751. The amendment strikes "cultural affairs department and inserts "state records center and archives". The amendment does not change the original intent of the bill.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

House Bill 751 appropriates \$25.0 from the general fund to DCA to fund the state historian's fellowship program for research in the state archives.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

House Bill 751 appropriates \$25.0 from general fund and is recurring. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.

**SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

According to DCA, the appropriation is directed to the Department of Cultural Affairs but the State Historian is a staff member of State Records Center and Archives.

**CONFLICT, DUPLICATION, COMPANIONSHIP, RELATIONSHIP**

Appears to be related in purpose to SB358 and HB 372

**TECHNICAL ISSUES**

DCA recommends that funding should be appropriated to State Records Center and Archives.
