WHEREAS, in past years politicians have delayed passing the defense appropriations bill until late in the budget year so that the defense appropriations bill has been misused as a dumping ground for pork barrel spending and as a political hostage to pork barrel spending in other appropriations bills; and

WHEREAS, in the wake of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001 on America, President George W. Bush asked that congress pass the defense appropriations bill before passing other spending bills; and

WHEREAS, congress acted responsibly in the 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005 budgets when it passed the defense appropriations bill first, thereby protecting the men and women in the armed forces from becoming pawns for politicians' spending maneuvers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that congress be commended for making the nation's defense its first priority in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005 and that the members of the New Mexico congressional delegation be requested to continue this important tradition by passing and enacting the defense appropriations bill before all other spending bills in 2006 and in future years; and
