A MEMORIAL

COMMENDING THE NEW MEXICO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INSTITUTE AT LAS

VEGAS FOR ITS ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN YEARS OF QUALITY CARE FOR

THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH OF NEW MEXICANS AND OTHERS.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico behavioral health institute at Las Vegas was founded in 1889 and serves the psychiatric care needs of the entire state; and

WHEREAS, the institute is the largest facility within the department of health; and

WHEREAS, the institute works in collaboration with law enforcement, the judiciary, the children, youth and families department, adult protective services, other agencies and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the institute provides patient-specific care planning and adult psychiatric, forensic, long-term care, .161805.1

WHEREAS, the institute has approximately one thousand
employees and contributes forty-four million dollars
(\$44,000,000) to the local and state economy;
