STRENGTHENING THE COLLABORATION BETWEEN SOUTHERN NEW MEXICO ENLACE AND NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY'S COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE TO IMPROVE THE EDUCATION OF HISPANIC STUDENTS.

WHEREAS, college attendance rates are low, resulting from the inadequate preparation of Hispanics at the pre-kindergarten through grade twelve level, and this poor educational profile has implications for the economic future of the state; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico state university's mission is to serve the educational needs of New Mexico's diverse populations and is the state's land grant college, and the federal Morrill Act reflects the belief that "American social and economic .161023.1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico state university cooperative extension service and southern New Mexico ENLACE explore ways to integrate the ENLACE parent university workshops into their scope of work to assist Hispanic parents to become "coaches" and "advocates" for their children's success and excellence; and
