RECOGNIZING THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE ALBUQUERQUE JUNIOR LEAGUE AND ITS CONTRIBUTIONS TO COMMUNITY IMPACT PROGRAMS THROUGH PUBLICATION OF ITS COOKBOOK, *SIMPLY SIMPATICO*.

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque junior league published its nationally renowned cookbook, *Simply Simpatico*, twenty-five years ago; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico recipes in the cookbook have reached the far corners of the world, increasing international recognition and awareness of New Mexico's delicious traditional regional cuisine; and

WHEREAS, the *Simply Simpatico* cookbook includes only original recipes from New Mexico residents, and many of the recipes included date back generations; and

14 spreading appreciation of New Mexico cuisine; and
