10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO  
12 PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO HOLDS AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FROM  
13 THE STATE AND WHO, IN GOOD FAITH, PROVIDES SERVICES  
14 VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT THE EXPECTATION OF COMPENSATION, SHALL NOT  
15 BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY CIVIL DAMAGES AS A RESULT OF AN ACT OR  
16 OMISSION IN PROVIDING THOSE SERVICES.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

19 Section 1. It is proposed to amend the constitution of  
20 New Mexico by enacting a new section to read:

21 "A person who is licensed by the state to practice an  
22 occupation and who, in good faith, provides services  
23 voluntarily within the scope of that license, without the  
24 expectation of compensation, shall not be held liable for any  
25 civil damages as a result of an act or omission in providing
