17	A. The "opiate replacement therapy for inmates
18	pilot project" is created as a two-year study that provides
19	opiate replacement treatment, utilizing buprenorphine/naloxone,
20	to fifty women with a history of heroin or other opiate
21	addiction who are incarcerated at and are to be released on
22	parole from the New Mexico women's correctional facility in
23	Grants and the Camino Nuevo correctional center. The project
24	shall include standard therapeutic community and addiction
25	counseling.

Opiate replacement therapy shall be administered 2 to fifty women with a history of heroin or other opiate 3 addiction who: 4 are within three months of release; (1) 5 (2) will be monitored on parole or probation for at least one year following release; 6 7 are not pregnant; and (3) 8 after being fully informed of (4) 9 buprenorphine/naloxone and its effects and of the requirements 10 and procedures for participation in the project, agree to 11 participate in the opiate replacement therapy for inmates pilot 12 project for two years. 13 Priority shall be given to those women who are C. 14 closest to being released from incarceration and to those 15 planning to parole to a community within sixty miles of a 16 physician certified to prescribe buprenorphine/naloxone 17 therapy. 18 D. Opiate replacement therapy with 19 buprenorphine/naloxone shall be made available to each 20 participant in the pilot project for two years. The impact of 21 the project on all participants shall be evaluated for two 22 years. 23 Ε. The corrections department shall collaborate 24 with the department of health to administer and evaluate the 25 opiate replacement therapy for inmates pilot project and to .164059.2

F. The corrections department in collaboration with the department of health shall evaluate the success of women who participate in the pilot project as compared to women with a history of opiate dependence who are not treated with buprenorphine/naloxone. The evaluation shall include findings about:

(1) recidivism, relapse and cost savings;

(2) the amount of psychotropic medication

used;

(3) the number of opiate-positive drug

(4) the rate and frequency of infection, selfinflicted injury and need for medical care; and

(5) the changes in physical and mental health status, employment status, parenting and other quality of life indicators during the project period.

G. The corrections department and department of health shall each report independently to the appropriate interim legislative committee on the evaluations, treatments and outcomes of the pilot project participants by December 1, 2008 and again by December 1, 2009.

H. The pilot project shall run from July 1, 2007
