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AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC MONEY; PROVIDING FOR
CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS;
PROVIDING FOR OPERATING EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS--LIMITATIONS--
REVERSIONS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in this section or
another section of this act, the unexpended balance of an
appropriation made in this act from the general fund shall
revert to the originating fund as follows:

(1) for projects for which appropriations
were made to match federal grants, six months after
completion of the project;

(2) for projects for which appropriations
were made to purchase vehicles, emergency vehicles or other
vehicles that require special equipment, heavy equipment,
educational technology or equipment or furniture that is not
related to a more inclusive construction or renovation
project, at the end of the fiscal year two years following
the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made for the
purchase; and

(3) for all other projects for which

1 appropriations were made, within six months of completion of
2 the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2011.

3 B. Upon certification by an agency that money from
4 the general fund is needed for a purpose specified in this
5 act, the secretary of finance and administration shall
6 disburse such amount of the appropriation for that project as
7 is necessary to meet that need.

8 C. Except for appropriations to the capital
9 program fund, money from appropriations made in this act
10 shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

11 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
12 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
13 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
14 written obligations to third parties.

15 Section 2. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT
16 PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are
17 appropriated from the general fund to the aging and long-term
18 services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2007
19 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this
20 act, for the following purposes:

21 1. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to make
22 improvements, including purchase and installation of
23 equipment, to the Armijo senior meal site in Bernalillo
24 county;

25 2. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to make

1 improvements, including purchase and installation of
2 equipment, to the Pajarito senior meal site in Bernalillo
3 county;

4 3. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to make
5 improvements, including purchase and installation of
6 equipment, to the Rio Bravo senior meal site in Bernalillo
7 county;

8 4. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
9 design, renovate and equip senior facilities in city council
10 district 1 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

11 5. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
12 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a senior center in
13 Tijeras in Bernalillo county;

14 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to make
15 improvements, including purchase and installation of
16 equipment, to the Springer senior center in Colfax county;

17 7. forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000) to
18 construct a garage at the Melrose senior center in Curry
19 county;

20 8. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
21 design, construct, expand and equip improvements, including
22 purchase and installation of equipment, to the Mesilla Park
23 community center in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;

24 9. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to
25 design and construct an expansion of the San Jose senior

1 center in Carlsbad in Eddy county;

2 10. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to make
3 improvements, including purchase and installation of
4 equipment, to the Puerto de Luna senior center in Guadalupe
5 county;

6 11. ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to make
7 improvements, including purchase and installation of
8 equipment, to La Loma senior center in Guadalupe county;

9 12. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
10 purchase and equip a vehicle for the Baca chapter senior
11 center in the Navajo Nation in McKinley county;

12 13. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
13 plan, design, construct and equip improvements to the senior
14 center in the Thoreau chapter of the Navajo Nation in
15 McKinley county;

16 14. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
17 plan, design, purchase or construct a senior center at the
18 Whitehorse Lake chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley
19 county;

20 15. thirteen thousand nine hundred dollars
21 (\$13,900) to furnish the senior center, including tables and
22 chairs, in Espanola in Rio Arriba county;

23 16. sixty-five thousand one hundred dollars
24 (\$65,100) to purchase and install equipment for the Ohkay
25 Owingeh senior center in Rio Arriba county;

1 17. twenty-three thousand eight hundred dollars
2 (\$23,800) to purchase and equip a van for transporting senior
3 citizens in Floyd in Roosevelt county;

4 18. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to
5 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip the Eldorado
6 senior center in the Eldorado area of Santa Fe county;

7 19. three hundred ten thousand one hundred dollars
8 (\$310,100) to purchase land and plan, design, construct and
9 equip a senior and community center in the Pojoaque valley
10 area in Santa Fe county;

11 20. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to make
12 improvements, including purchase and installation of
13 furnishings and equipment, to the Pasatiempo senior center in
14 Santa Fe county;

15 21. seventy-eight thousand nine hundred dollars
16 (\$78,900) to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and
17 furnish, including improvements to the parking lot and
18 landscaping, the Edgewood senior center in Santa Fe county;

19 22. fifty-seven thousand seven hundred dollars
20 (\$57,700) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a
21 facility for the senior center in Edgewood in Santa Fe
22 county;

23 23. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
24 design and construct additional facility space at the
25 Edgewood senior center in Edgewood in Santa Fe county;

1 24. five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to purchase and
2 install equipment and furnishings for the Phil Lovato senior
3 center in Taos in Taos county; and

4 25. fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to
5 purchase and equip a food delivery truck to deliver hot meals
6 to seniors in Valencia county.

7 Section 3. STATE ARMORY BOARD PROJECT--GENERAL
8 FUND.--Three million one hundred ninety-eight thousand eight
9 hundred dollars (\$3,198,800) is appropriated from the general
10 fund to the state armory board for expenditure in fiscal
11 years 2007 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section
12 1 of this act, for renovations at armory facilities
13 statewide.

14 Section 4. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--GENERAL
15 FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from the
16 general fund to the capital program fund for expenditure in
17 fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in
18 Section 1 of this act, for the following purposes:

19 1. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)
20 to plan, design and construct improvements to infrastructure
21 at the Santa Teresa port of entry in Dona Ana county; and

22 2. three million dollars (\$3,000,000) to plan,
23 design, construct, renovate and equip a substance abuse
24 treatment center in Los Lunas in Valencia county.

25 Section 5. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--

1 GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from
2 the general fund to the cultural affairs department for
3 expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless
4 otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, for the
5 following purposes:

6 1. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for a
7 fresco painting at the Torreon building at the national
8 Hispanic cultural center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

9 2. ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) for
10 renovations to the visitor center facilities and site at
11 Lincoln state monument in Lincoln county;

12 3. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
13 plan, design and construct renovations and purchase equipment
14 for the museum of international folk art in Santa Fe in Santa
15 Fe county;

16 4. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for phase 1
17 construction of the New Mexico archaeology center to serve as
18 a research and collections repository for the state's
19 archaeological collection in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

20 5. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
21 design, construct, equip and furnish improvements to and
22 expansion of the Santa Fe children's museum in Santa Fe in
23 Santa Fe county;

24 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to construct
25 and equip El Camino Real international heritage center in

1 Socorro in Socorro county;

2 7. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
3 design and construct improvements to El Camino Real
4 international heritage center in Socorro in Socorro county;

5 8. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
6 plan, design and implement an interactive fine arts outreach
7 program to be available statewide;

8 9. four hundred thirty-four thousand dollars
9 (\$434,000) to purchase bookmobiles for use statewide; and

10 10. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for
11 restoration and conservation of the state's public art
12 collection statewide.

13 Section 6. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL
14 DISTRICT PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--Twenty-five thousand dollars
15 (\$25,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
16 district attorney of the first judicial district for
17 expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless
18 otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, to purchase a
19 vehicle for the first judicial district attorney's office in
20 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

21 Section 7. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE THIRD JUDICIAL
22 DISTRICT PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--Forty-three thousand dollars
23 (\$43,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
24 district attorney of the third judicial district for
25 expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless

1 otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, to purchase and
2 equip secretarial workstations for the third judicial
3 district attorney's office in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county.

4 Section 8. FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
5 GENERAL FUND.--Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) is
6 appropriated from the general fund to the first judicial
7 district court for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through
8 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, to
9 purchase, install and equip an electronic document management
10 system in the first judicial district court in Santa Fe in
11 Santa Fe county.

12 Section 9. THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
13 GENERAL FUND.--One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is
14 appropriated from the general fund to the third judicial
15 district court for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through
16 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, for
17 architectural planning, including a needs assessment, for the
18 third judicial district court in Dona Ana county.

19 Section 10. FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--
20 GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from
21 the general fund to the fifth judicial district court for
22 expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless
23 otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, for the
24 following purposes:

- 25 1. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to

1 purchase and install information technology and furniture for
2 the district court in Carlsbad in Eddy county; and

3 2. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
4 purchase equipment, furnishings and information technology
5 for the fifth judicial district court in Lovington in Lea
6 county.

7 Section 11. ELEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
8 GENERAL FUND.--One hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
9 (\$175,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
10 eleventh judicial district court for expenditure in fiscal
11 years 2007 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section
12 1 of this act, to purchase and install interactive, audio and
13 visual equipment, including information technology, for the
14 eleventh judicial district in San Juan and McKinley counties.

15 Section 12. TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
16 GENERAL FUND.--Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) is
17 appropriated from the general fund to the twelfth judicial
18 district court for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through
19 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, to
20 purchase and install chairs in the twelfth judicial district
21 courtrooms in Lincoln and Otero counties.

22 Section 13. THIRTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT-
23 -GENERAL FUND.--Eighteen thousand eight hundred dollars
24 (\$18,800) is appropriated from the general fund to the
25 thirteenth judicial district court for expenditure in fiscal

1 years 2007 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section
2 1 of this act, to purchase and install information
3 technology, including related equipment and furniture, for
4 the thirteenth judicial district court in Sandoval county.

5 Section 14. DNA IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM FUND PROJECT--
6 GENERAL FUND.--One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is
7 appropriated from the general fund to the DNA identification
8 system fund for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through
9 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, to
10 purchase and install information technology and wiring,
11 including related equipment and furniture, in jails and
12 detention centers statewide, contingent on the passage of
13 legislation during the first session of the forty-eighth
14 legislature that establishes requirements for the collection
15 of DNA samples from all persons eighteen years of age or over
16 who are arrested for certain felony offenses and for the
17 submission of DNA samples collected pursuant to medical
18 examinations of sexual assault victims.

19 Section 15. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROJECT--
20 GENERAL FUND.--Eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) is
21 appropriated from the general fund to the economic
22 development department for expenditure in fiscal years 2007
23 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this
24 act, to acquire land for, plan, design and construct a meat
25 processing plant, including site improvements, for the Ramah

1 chapter of the Navajo Nation in Gallup in McKinley county.

2 Section 16. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
3 GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from
4 the general fund to the public education department for
5 expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011, unless
6 otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, for the
7 following purposes:

8 1. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
9 and install educational technology, including related

11 Section 38. UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO PROJECTS--GENERAL
12 FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from the
13 general fund to the board of regents of the university of New
14 Mexico for expenditure in fiscal years 2007 through 2011,
15 unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of this act, for the
16 following purposes:

17 1. sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to
18 purchase and install distance learning equipment at the
19 Charlie Morrissey research center for the department of
20 African American studies at the university of New Mexico in
21 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

22 2. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
23 continue environmental and health research and demonstration
24 projects, including those related to advancing knowledge of
25 precautionary principles, sustainable development and healthy

1 communities, by the alliance for transportation institute at
2 the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
3 county;

4 3. one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars
5 (\$135,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish an
6 alumni center at the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque
7 in Bernalillo county;

8 4. eighty-seven thousand dollars (\$87,000) to
9 purchase equipment, including tractors and utility vehicles,
10 and to plan, design and construct a fence adjacent to a wild
11 horse preserve in Socorro county for the mammal division of
12 the biology department at the university of New Mexico;

13 5. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
14 and install equipment at the Carlisle gymnasium at the
15 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

16 6. one hundred forty-three thousand nine hundred
17 dollars (\$143,900) for golf hitting bays at the university of
18 New Mexico golf course in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

19 7. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to
20 purchase digital photography and editing equipment for the
21 graduate studies building at the university of New Mexico in
22 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

23 8. twenty-three thousand eight hundred dollars
24 (\$23,800) to plan, design, renovate, repair, construct,
25 furnish and equip Hodgin hall for use as an alumni center at

1 the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
2 county;

3 9. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to plan,
4 design, purchase and install lighting at Johnson field at the
5 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

6 10. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for
7 constructing, purchasing and installing equipment for the
8 manufacturing training and technology center clean room at
9 the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
10 county;

11 11. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan
12 and design the Native American learning center at the
13 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

14 12. three hundred seventy-five thousand one
15 hundred dollars (\$375,100) to plan, design and construct a
16 facility for the Tamarind institute at the university of New
17 Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

18 13. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
19 design, construct and renovate a facility to house the
20 intertribal Indian ceremonial collection at the Gallup branch
21 of the university of New Mexico in McKinley county; and

22 14. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
23 plan, design and construct a building at the university of
24 New Mexico west campus in Rio Rancho in Sandoval county.

25 Section 39. WESTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY PROJECT--

1 GENERAL FUND.--Forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) is
2 appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of
3 western New Mexico university for expenditure in fiscal years
4 2007 through 2011, unless otherwise provided in Section 1 of
5 this act, to purchase and install information technology for
6 the Gallup graduate studies center of western New Mexico
7 university in Gallup in McKinley county.

8 Section 40. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--If an
9 appropriation for a project authorized in this act is not
10 sufficient to complete all the purposes specified, the
11 appropriation may be expended for any portion of the purposes
12 specified in the appropriation. Expenditures shall not be
13 made for purposes other than those specified in the
14 appropriation.

15 Section 41. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--Pursuant to Section
16 13-4A-4 NMSA 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations
17 authorized in this act include one percent for the art in
18 public places fund.

19 Section 42. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
20 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
21 immediately. _____

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
