**Short Title: Character Building Youth Dance Program**

### **Bill Summary:**

HB 506 makes an appropriation to support character-building youth dance programs in partnership with school districts statewide.

## **Fiscal Impact:**

\$300,000 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD) for FY 09. The bill contains a reversion clause.

#### **Issues:**

According to CYFD's analysis of similar bills, evidence suggests that youth who are involved in activities such as sports, music, and drama help build a sense of self-worth and self-respect. They consistently show lower rates of substance use and gang involvement. They may also demonstrate healthier functioning on such indicators as academic achievement, psychological adjustment, and improved quality and quantity of interactions with their parents.
